For the upcoming training year, the program is offering 3 training tracks: 1) The Menninger Clinic - Adult Psychology Track (1 position), 2) TIRR Memorial Hermann - Rehabilitation Psychology/Neuropsychology Track (1 position), and 3) OCD and Related Disorders Track (3 positions).
