#### Please Note:

• There are no special diet or medication restrictions for this test.



#### Do not take the test:

- Three days before, during or after your period, or
- If you have bleeding hemorrhoids, blood in urine, open cuts on hands, or strained bowel movements the same day.

## **Before You Start the Test**

- Take the small tube out of the envelope.
- **Do not** use the test kit after the expiration date on the carton and vial labels.
- Check your name and date on the sampling bottle

# **Doing the Test**

- **Do not** collect stool sample from toilet bowl water.
- 1. Urinate before your bowel movement.
- 2. Collect the stool in a clean, dry container, such as:
  - Paper plate
  - Small cardboard box
  - Bucket

You can line the container with the enclosed collection paper.



3. Open green cap by turning to the left and pulling upwards.



- 4. Scrape the surface of the fecal sample with the sample stick.
- 5. Cover the grooved portion of the sample stick completely with stool sample.
  - **6.** Close sampling bottle by inserting the sample stick and screwing cap on tightly to the right. Do not reopen.

#### **Handling the Sample**

- Flush any stool in the toilet.
- If you used the collection paper, flush it down the toilet.
- Store the sampling bottle at room temperature 36-86F.

#### After the Test



**1.** Wrap the sampling bottle with the absorbent pad provided.



2. Put the sampling bottle into the specimen bag.



**3.** Bring the complete kit to your clinic **OR** mail the complete kit.

You have finished the test! If your result is positive. you will be contacted to schedule a colonoscopy.
