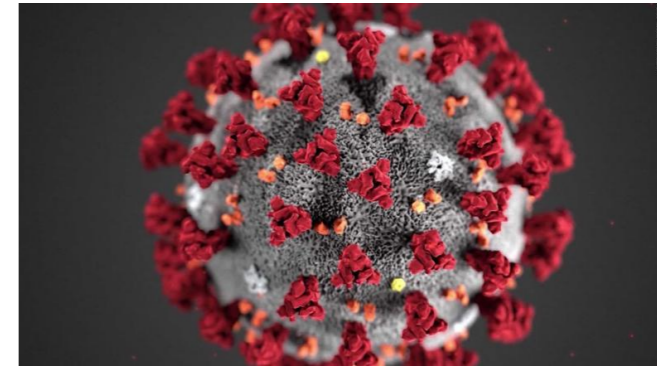

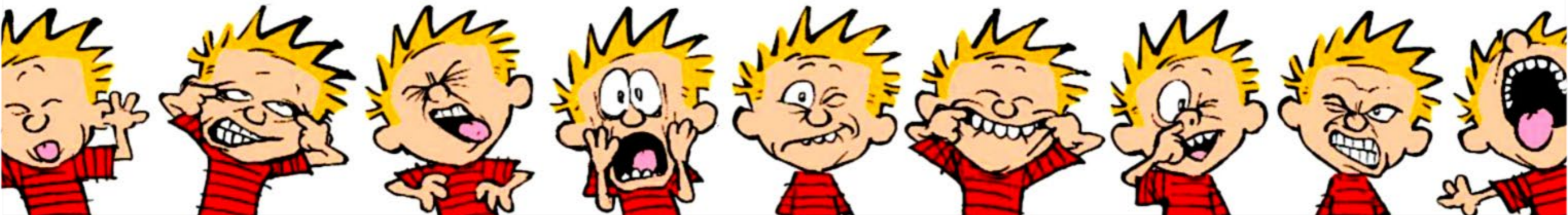

BCM FEDERATED LOGIN – SINGLE SIGN-ON

- ▶ Must use your BCM username and password for access
- ▶ VPN not required
- ▶ If you get locked out by trying 3 or more times to login, you must contact the BCM Helpdesk at 713-798-8737 or you can log onto the Password Self-Service and change your password: <https://password.bcm.edu>
- ▶ If you get an error message when logging in:

Symptoms

Users experience a 404 error when trying to access an internal BCM web site that requires authentication.

Cause

The cause for this error is cached logon credentials. The web browser has cached, or saved, previously used user name and password.

Resolution

The user needs to delete the browser's cached, or saved, logon credentials. (clear the browser cookies)

- ▶ (Keyword search in the IT Service Portal on “Clear” will pull this up.)



BCM Password Set Up

How to decipher 1st initial password

- First letter of first name Upper Case
- Second letter of first name lower case
- The @ Symbol
- Last 4 of the BCM ID number
- First two letters of last name lower case

Example

John Doe

BCM ID: 123456

Password: Jo@3456do

Set up your BCM password

Your initial password

BCM provides you an initial password (see sidebar) so you can log into BCM Password Manager and set up your own custom password. The initial password **MUST** be reset prior to accessing any BCM enterprise systems. To reset your initial password, visit the BCM Password Manager site at <https://password.bcm.edu>.

Step 1. Register with Password Manager

When you first visit the Password Manager site, you will be required to complete the Password Manager registration process, which is setting up three security questions and answers in your profile. These security questions may be used as an alternate login method into the password manager site if you forget your password. In addition, you will enter a Help Desk question to register, which may be used by the helpdesk to help verify your identity over the phone.

To begin, click the **Register** task and follow the prompts.

Step 2. Set up your custom password

Once you have completed the registration process, you can change your initial password by clicking the **Manage My Password** task and follow the prompts. Per BCM policy, your password:

What is your initial password?

John Doe, with BCM ID number 123456, would have an initial password of Jo@3456do, based on the following formula:

- First letter of first name uppercase
- Second letter of first name lowercase
- AT sign '@'
- Last four (4) digits of the BCM ID Number.
- First two letters of last name lower case

You can use the same formula to find your initial password based on your name and BCM ID number.

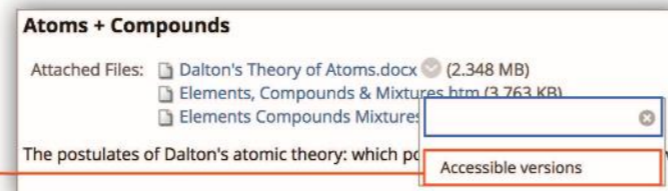

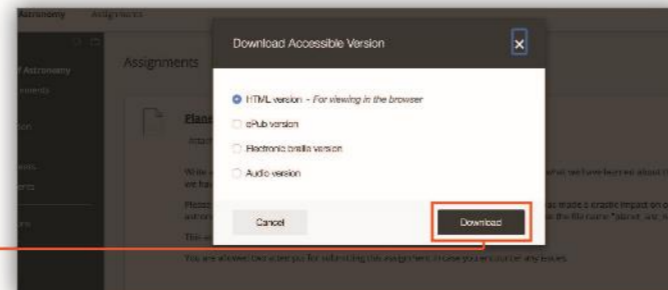
In your Blackboard course, locate a file's menu and select **"Accessible versions"**.



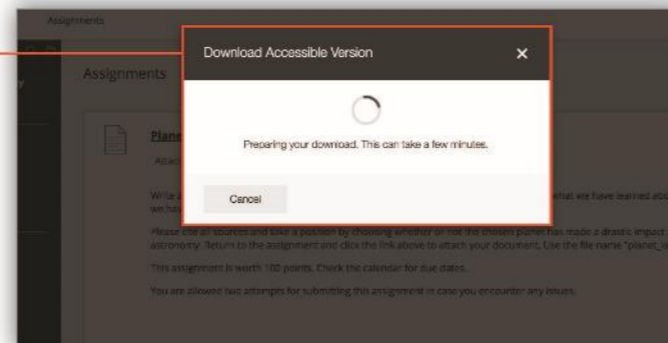
Download Accessible Files

Once you found your course file, select the file dropdown and select Accessible versions.

A pop-up window lists accessible file options. Accessible versions may vary depending on the file type. Choose a version and select **"Download"**.



If this is your first download of a specific file type, a Preparing download notification appears. The download may take multiple minutes to complete.



Once your file downloads, you can open or save the accessible version. You can also return to the original file to get different versions. The instructor's original file will always remain in your course, regardless of which alternatives you select.

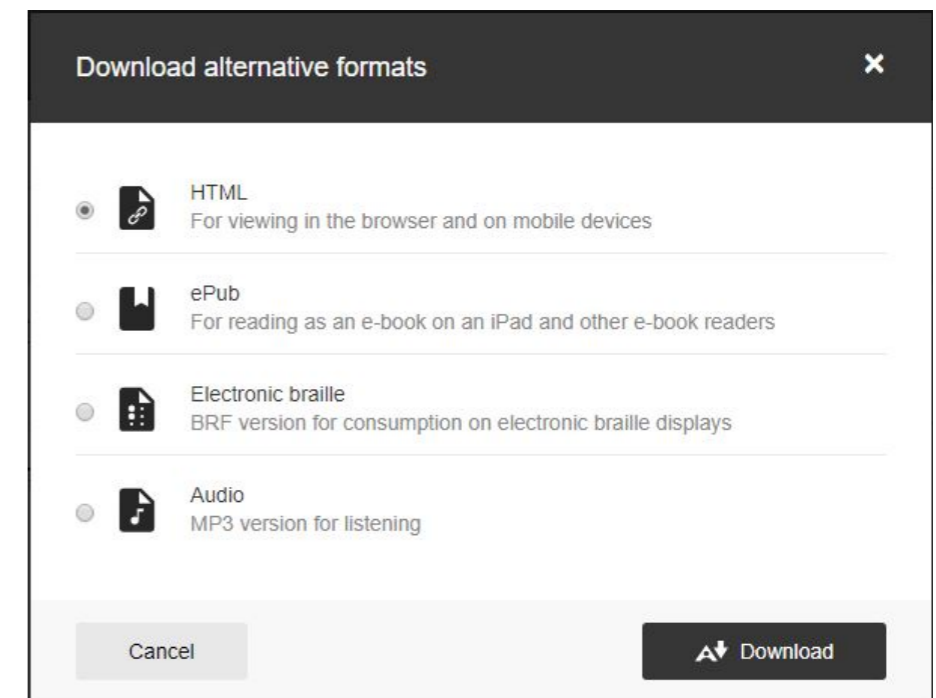
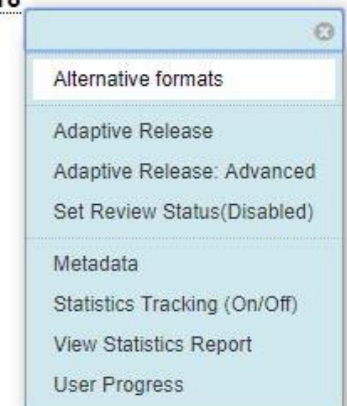

EXAM ID & EXAM MONITOR

How It Works:

- ▶ Exam takers establish a “baseline” of authentication the first time they launch their first exam.
- ▶ For each subsequent assessment, exam takers will be verified against their username/password, and device’s webcam.
- ▶ Validated exam takers will be able to proceed with their assessments.
- ▶ An additional layer of security will be included through ExamMonitor, which provides proctoring services via webcam throughout the assessment.
- ▶ Once the exam is complete, the proctoring files are uploaded alongside the exam answer files and stored within ExamSoft.

- ▶ Only needed to access BCM resources from off campus
 - ▶ Used to access Up-to-Date
- ▶ Must be on the BCM network to set this up.
- ▶ Only the ERC Option works for BCM resources like Up-to-Date (VPN not needed for Blackboard or ExamSoft)
- ▶ Note: Any computer connecting remotely to the BCM network must be up-to-date with all operating system security updates and anti-virus definitions.

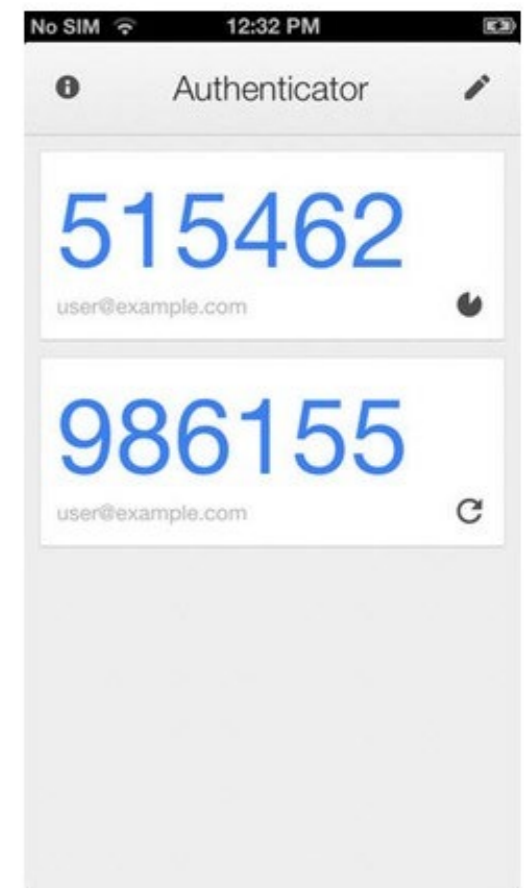

HOW TO INSTALL VPN

- ▶ Open your browser
- ▶ Go to vpn.bcm.edu and follow the directions
- ▶ Must install the Google Authenticator app on your mobile device to provide the secure token to enter into the VPN app.
 - ▶ For detailed instructions on how to install the Google Authenticator: <https://it.bcm.edu> (Use MFA in the keyword search)
 - ▶ Once the Google Authenticator app is installed, the token refreshes every 15 seconds, so you have to be quick in entering it into VPN.
 - ▶ Must be on the BCM network to set this up.





Warning: Since this involves a software installation, your laptop/desktop computer may request “permission” several times during this installation.

- ▶ Change your BCM password.

- ▶ Your 1st BCM Password is **TEMPORARY** and only last for **10 working days** - making it necessary to setup Wi-Fi again!

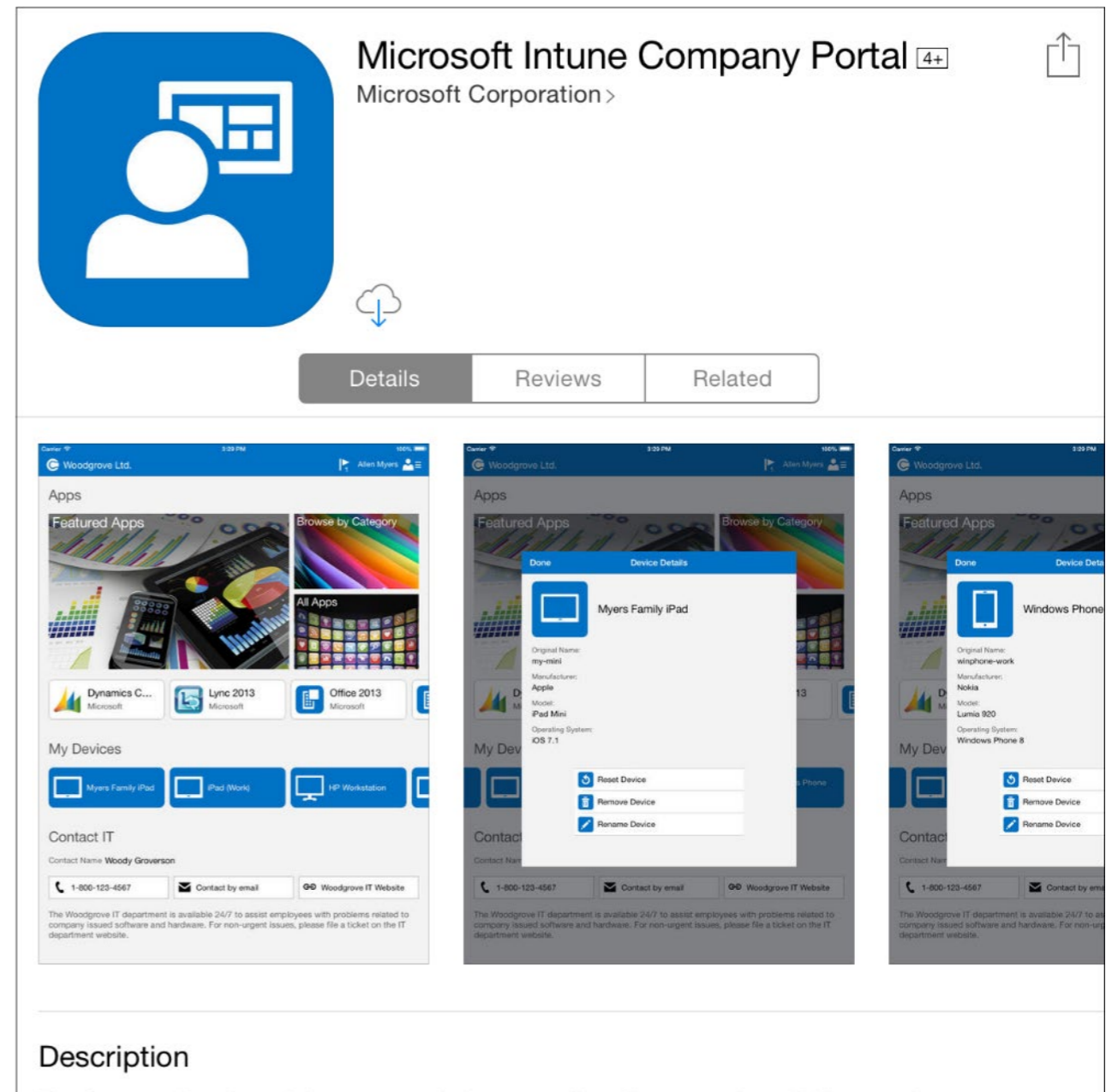
BCM-WIFI NETWORK

- ▶ Wireless connectivity is available in all BCM buildings throughout campus. If prompted, use your BCM username and password.
- ▶ You will need the BCM Wireless Network to:
 - ▶ Access the BCM Intranet
 - ▶ Access applications that BCM licenses
 - ▶ Change your BCM password
- ▶ Do not configure the Guest Network
- ▶ If you change your password. Log out of any mobile devices before making the change. Make the change, then log back into your devices. If not, you may get locked out.

MOBILE DEVICES

WHAT PHONES DOES BCM SUPPORT FOR EMAIL

- BCM supports the iPhone and Android
- To set up your email, you must download the Mobile Device Management (MDM) app called Microsoft Intune and follow the instructions for configuration.

MFA & MDM

MFA is Baylor's 2 Step Verification for various sites

2 Step is triggered when outside of the BCM network

There are 2 Ways of Authenticating

- Google Authenticator
- SMS Authentication

MDM is the ability to add BCM email to your mobile device

It is separate from MFA

Manages mobile devices passively to ensure security of potential sensitive information

It is required for all Office applications on mobile devices such as teams and power apps.

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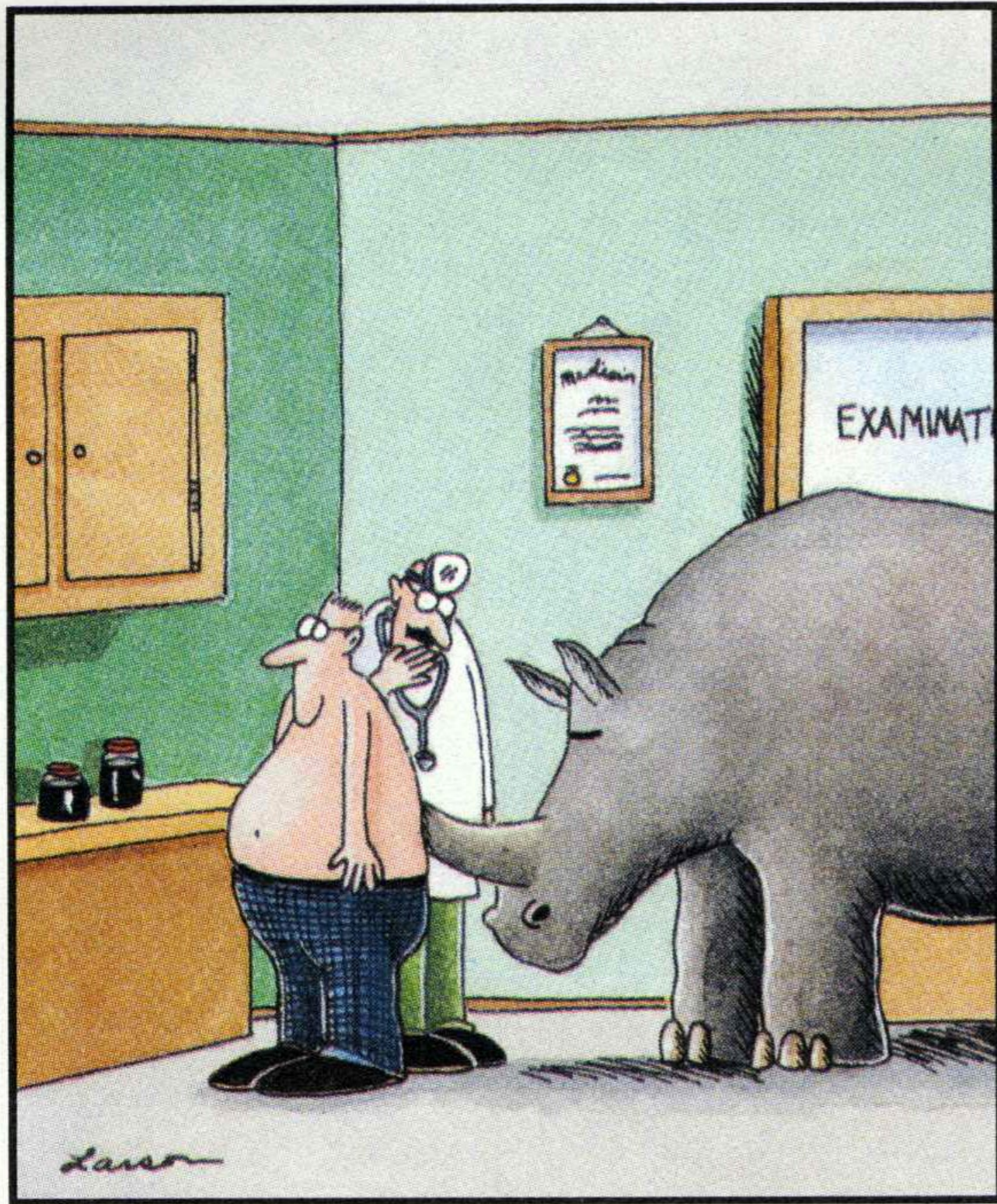
