You must have a physical transcript mailed from this institution.*

If you are currently enrolled (completing degree requirements), please wait until your transcript is finalized (degree posted) before you have it sent to Baylor.

Any transcripts submitted through the AAMC portal during the admissions process **do not fulfill this requirement**. Even if the transcript you previously submitted showed your completed degree, you will need to have an additional official final transcript submitted to the Office of the Registrar as required by your acceptance into BCM.

You do not have to send a transcript from a college/university if you did not receive a degree from the college/university.
