Current Regularly Scheduled Events

Research Mentoring Foundations Workshop: Offered spring and fall. The 4-hour long workshop utilizes CIMER mentor training materials and qualifies as evidence-based mentor training for the National Institutes of Health and National Science Foundation interests.



- Scientific Communication Advances Research Excellence (SCOARE): Offered spring and fall. This 6-hour workshop covers approaches on how to mentor students and trainees in scientific communication offering practical strategies for mentors.
- **Culturally Aware Mentoring:** Offered spring and fall. These evidence-based sessions are designed to help mentors advance their mentorship practices around creating inclusive and supportive research environments. Each session will be led by an experienced facilitators using an evidence-based curriculum.
- Career Advancement Series: The Career Advancement Series is a BCM program supporting early career and midcareer faculty in further developing skills and competencies that support professional and personal goals for advancement and leadership development at Baylor College of Medicine. The 6-session series runs from November through May.

<u>Peer Coaching for Educators</u>: Peer coaching may be requested for a variety of <u>educational settings</u>, such as lectures, grand rounds, clinical rounds, small group-based learning, one-on-one interactions, and more. Documentation from this process is particularly valuable in applying for teaching awards (e.g. <u>Norton Rose Fulbright Award</u>) and/or promotion (as part of your educational portfolio).

CLINICAL SCIENTIST TRAINING PROGRAM (Houston Based)

The CSTP offers Ph.D. (for faculty only) and M.S. (for faculty and senior residents / fellows) degrees in clinical investigation through the Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences. Both multi-year programs are designed for academic clinicians with a significant commitment to clinical research.

TEXAS MEDICAL CENTER LIBRARY (BCM Login Required)

- Access medical and research journals as well as to other periodicals such as the Harvard Business Review and the Chronicle of Higher Education.
- Have a literature search performed on a medical topic (average turn-around time for literature searches is three business days per request).
- Explore DigitalCommons@TMC, an open-access digital repository serving the Texas Medical Center community providing permanent and free access to works authored by TMC scholars and researchers.
