Intern selection is based on trainees' clinical experience and goodness of fit with the specific training track. The internship program provides broad-based training within a scientist-practitioner model. Through a competency-based approach to training, the program prepares students for subsequent licensure as psychologists. For the upcoming training year, the program is offering 8 training tracks: 1) The Menninger Clinic Adult Division Track (1 position), 2) TIRR Memorial Hermann - Rehabilitation Psychology/Neuropsychology Track (1 position), 3) OCD and Related Disorders Track (4 positions), 4) Mood Disorders Track (1 position), 5) Ben Taub Hospital General Track (1 position), 6) Law Enforcement and First Responders Family and Child Track (1 position), 7) The Menninger Clinic - Adolescent & Young Adult Division Track (1 position), and 8) Harris Center Child and Adolescent Track (1 position).
