Our fellowship program operates on a 13-block rotation. Fellows complete thirteen 4-week blocks versus the traditional 12 months.

Fellows have the option to divide 4-week blocks into 2-week blocks to customize their schedule.

Vacation: 21 days/year that can be used up to 1 week at each time in the blocks of Elective, Scholarly Activity, Pathology, Radiation Oncology/Radiology, or Outpatient.

Time off: at least 1 day a week when 4 weeks averaged.

Fellows attend ½ day per week continuity clinic on inpatient and BMT rotations.

Fellows attend 1 day per week continuity clinic on all other (non-inpatient/non-BMT) rotations.

Electives include additional training in bone marrow transplant, neuro-oncology, palliative care, hematology, consultation, cancer genetics, or vascular anomalies.

Weekday home call (Monday, Tuesday, & Thursday nights while on inpatient rotations only)

Weekend call (Friday 4pm – Monday 8am) 1 weekend per research, elective, and any outpatient month (pathology, radiology, clinic).

Longitudinal Curriculum: Leadership, Quality, Professional development, Mentorship, Education, Scholarly Writing

Inpatient Call – Monday 8am – Friday 4pm (While on Inpatient Rotations)
