Windows that is frequently utilized in Mathematical Sciences, Social Sciences, Data Analysis and Mining, Biological Sciences, Software Engineering, Bioinformatics, Medical Imaging, and many others.

 - (3) Check email for link to download installer,
 - (4) Create WolframID and download installer,
 - (5) Run installer and enter Activation Key

 - (2) Choose the type of license key you are requesting
 - (3) Fill in the license details, and click Continue after reading the license agreement
 - (4) Fill in the required contact information and <u>use your BCM email</u>, <u>@bcm.edu</u>
 - (5) Check your email. You should receive notification about your request for a home-use license.
 - (6) Wolfram *Mathematica* will review your home use license request, and after verification will send you a license number and link to download the software. Note: Wolfram typically takes 24 hours to process your request
 - (7) You will receive a email titled "Your Wolfram Research Order" that will contain a link for the home-use download and the activation key.
 - (8) Run installer and enter Activation Key
