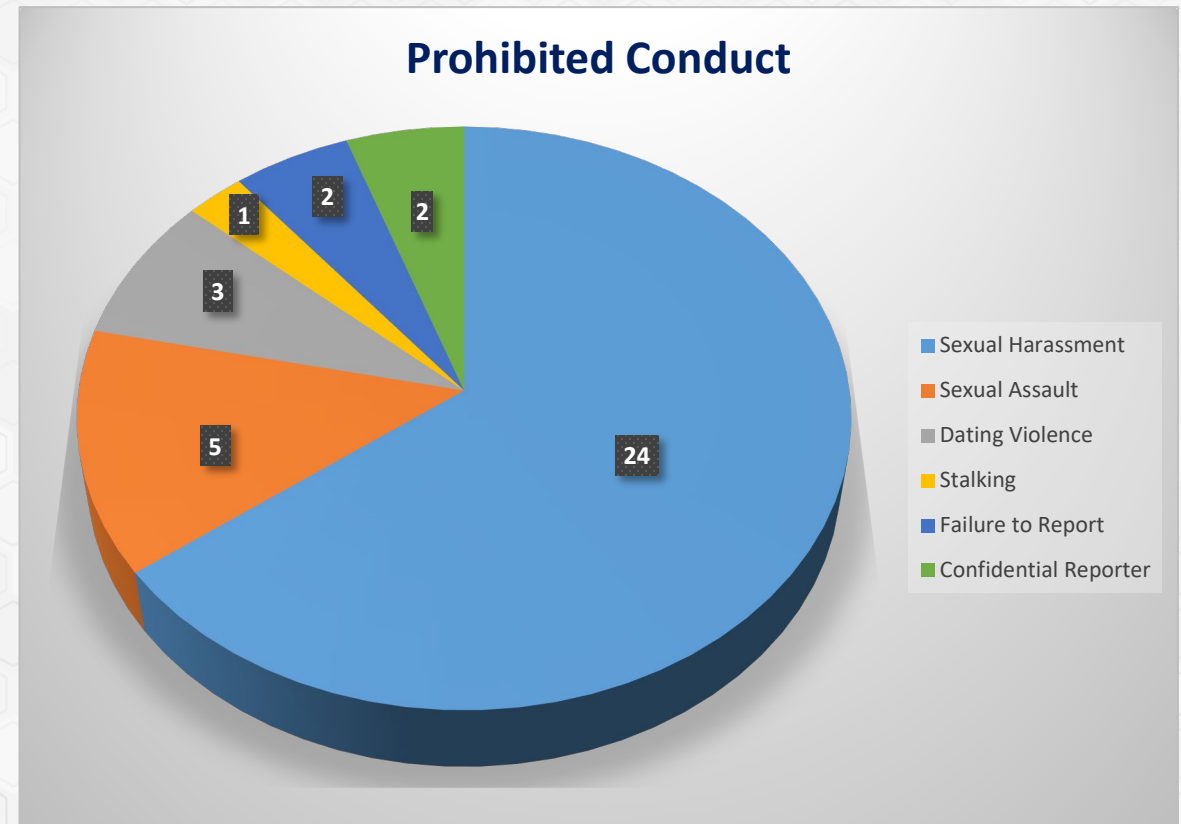

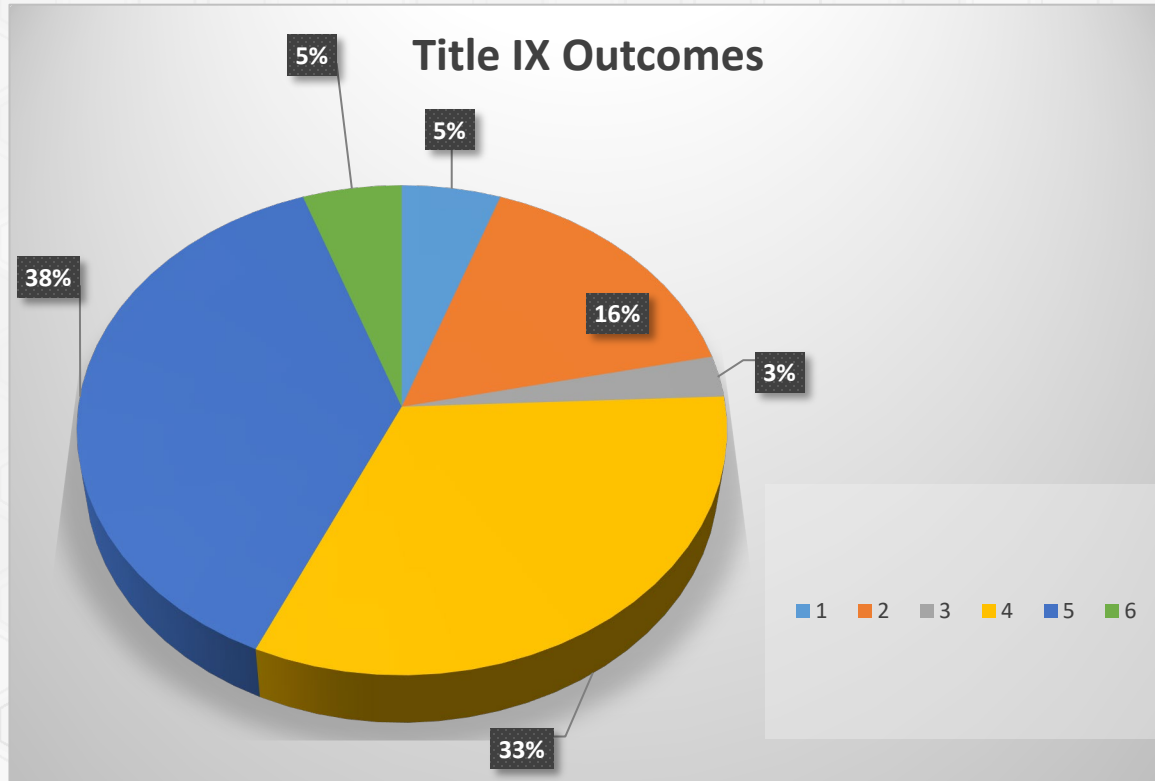
Reporting Source
