Final Electronic transcripts sent from an institution through a secure transcript delivery system may be sent to registrar@bcm.edu. Please note that we are unable to accept electronic transcripts through the University of Texas at Austin transcript service, and you must have a physical transcript mailed from this institution.

If you are currently enrolled (completing degree requirements), wait until your transcript is finalized (degree posted) before you have it sent to Baylor.

Even though you may have completed your formal education and sent a final transcript to the AAMC during the admissions process, Baylor requires an official transcript from the institution to be on file in your academic record.

You do not have to send a transcript from a college/university, if you did not receive a degree from the college/university.
