Internship Program Admissions

The Psychology Internship Program at Baylor College of Medicine provides broad-based training within a scientist-practitioner model. Through a competency-based approach to training, the program prepares psychology doctoral students (PhD and PsyD) for subsequent licensure as psychologists. Before applying through APPIC, applicants should determine which training track(s) best matches their graduate training and career goals. For the upcoming training year, the program is offering 4 training tracks: 1) The Menninger Clinic - Adult Psychology Track (1 position), 2) TIRR Memorial Hermann - Rehabilitation Psychology/Neuropsychology Track (1 position), and 3) OCD and Related Disorders Track (4 positions), and Mood Disorders Track (1 position).
