For the 2023-2024 training year, the program is offering 7 training tracks: 1) The Menninger Clinic - Adult Division Track (1 position), 2) TIRR Memorial Hermann - Rehabilitation Psychology/Neuropsychology Track (1 position), 3) OCD and Related Disorders Track (4 positions), 4) Mood Disorders Track (1 position), 5) Child and Adolescent Track (1 position), 6) Law Enforcement and First Responders Family and Child Track (1 position), and 7) The Menninger Clinic - Adolescent & Young Adult Division Track (1 position).

Applicants must have a minimum of 3 years of graduate course work in a doctoral level, APA-accredited or CPA-accredited clinical psychology or counseling psychology training program. Applicants must also have completed their program's comprehensive or qualifying exams at the time of application.
